

TREASURER'S REPORT. 2015-2016

We finished the financial year in credit to the tune of around £5,500.

We have a good increase in membership, around 80 at the last count. If numbers continue to increase then we may have to have a waiting list!

Attendance has been good, averaging 12-13 tables. Over the year the range has been between ten and fifteen tables which makes for a good number each evening with a range of ability making the evening enjoyable.

We introduced a lower table money cost from £2.50 to £2.00 which we introduced last September. Our annual profit next year will probably be slightly lower because a whole year will have been run on £2.00 not just 8 months. (About £400 less)

Our healthy balance has enabled the club to update certain items as required. This year money has been spent on:

- New computer
- Extra bidding boxes
- Computer scorers
- Cards

All these items help to ensure we use modern equipment and maintain a high standard in the equipment we use.

We are in the process of buying New tables and New cloths and possibly new blinds. Thanks to the expertise of Ed we have not had to replace all the tables which were breaking as he has done a good job in repairing those that were possible to repair. Not all of them were possible so to do.
